Palm Sunday ~ April 2nd, 2023



Isaiah 50:4-7

In Isaiah's reading, the third Servant Song, we see Jesus being obedient by the things He suffers. He perseveres because He knows that He has acted blamelessly, and that God is with Him. And if God is on His side, no one can triumph over Him. In a world of darkness do you walk confidently because you trust in God? When have you experienced someone you know depend on human scheming instead of depending on God? What was the result?


